TRANSYLVANIA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

October 14, 2016

The Transylvania County Board of Elections met in emergency session on Friday, October 14, 2016, at 11:00 AM in the office of the Board of Elections, 150 South Gaston Street, Brevard. Chairman David P. Morrow presided. Others present were Board Secretary John K. Barker, Member Sara G. Champion, Director Tracie Fisher, and Aubrey Woodard.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Morrow. The only item of business was to discuss parking during early voting and on election day at the Election Center. Ms. Fisher had contacted Jaime Laughter, County Manager, requesting parking spaces reserved for voters during early voting and on election day. Ms. Laughter denied the request stating the need for the public to have access to other county functions. Per NCGS 163-129 the Board may require adequate parking for voters at a tax-supported building. Ms. Champion moved that the Director compose a letter from Chairman Morrow that the Board, as authorized by statute, has determined that the 33 spaces in front of the Election Center will be adequate parking for voters and the public conducting other county business if the county employees will park at the old election office. The motion carried.

There was no additional business for the Board's consideration. Ms. Champion moved to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 11:30 AM. The next meeting of the Board will be held on October 18, 2016 at 5:00 PM in the Election Center located at, 150 South Gaston Street, Suite A for the Board to consider absentee ballots.


