

MINUTES  
TRANSYLVANIA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS  
May 18, 2018


The Transylvania County Board of Elections met to conduct the canvass for the May 8, 2018 election, and conduct other business on Friday, May 18, 2018 at 11:00 AM in the office of the Board, 150 South Gaston Street, Brevard, Chairwoman Sara G. Champion presiding. Others present were Vice Chairman David P. Morrow, Secretary Lee McMinn, Member Pam Dashiell, Director Tracie T. Fisher, Deputy Directors Jeff Storey and Laura Owen and Kathleen Barnes.

Chairwoman Champion called the meeting to order. Ms. Fisher explained the process for canvass to those in attendance. The Board canvassed the election to determine that the votes have been counted and tabulated correctly and authenticated the official results. The Board reviewed reports compiled by staff, reports from the State Election Information System, reports for the Unity election night reporting system, voting machine vote total tapes from the iVotronic, M-100 and DS-200 machines, and the "Chain of Custody" documents completed by the Chief Judge of each precinct. Mr. Morrow made a motion to release the results reviewed as the official results of the May 8, 2018 Primary Election and to execute the official abstract for the election; seconded by Pam Dashiell. The motion carried.

Chairwoman Champion asked for public comment. There was none.

There was no further business for the Board's consideration. Ms. Dashiell made a motion for the meeting to be adjourned; seconded by Mr. McMinn. The motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 12:15 PM. The next meeting of the Board is scheduled for Thursday, June 7, 2018 at 10:00 AM for the Board to conduct regular business at the Board office, 150 South Gaston Street, Brevard.


